On your child's testing days, we ask that your child **please be at school on time**, and have had a **good night's sleep** and **breakfast**, either at home or here at school. iPads should remain at school during this time, however, if for some reason it finds its way home, please charge it and make sure your child brings it to school daily. Parents may choose to have their student exempted from these screenings by providing written notification to the school clinic before the scheduled screening date.
