For families of students **currently** attending MPSA who will **continue attending** MPSA next school year: If you are going to be applying for their sibling(s) to attend MPSA in this year's lottery for the 2026-2027 school year, **please fill out this survey**.

It is important that you fill out this survey so that we can allocate a spot for the sibling if we have spots available.

The survey above is not the application. To apply for your child to attend, you must apply here in addition to the above. You must indicate that you have a sibling on the application and will need their student ID number, which can be found in ParentVUE or on any of their school documents.

## **Introducing a New Face at MPSA**

Lani previously worked for 13 years as a kindergarten assistant in FCPS. She sings in three choirs, plays the piano and organ and enjoys visiting her children and grandchildren as much as possible!

## **Upcoming Child Protection Unit in Counseling Lessons**

School counselors across APS provided bullying prevention lessons in October to strengthen our efforts in creating safe and supportive school environments.

As an natural extension of supporting our students with bullying, we recognize the sad fact of child abuse as one of the largest public health crisis facing children (ages 0 to 18) around the world. Again this year, elementary counselors will deliver one grade level specific child protection lesson from the *Second Step* evidence-based program to K-5 classrooms in December.

Students will learn ways to help them decide if something is safe or not: specifically, about safe, unsafe, and unwanted touches, and rules about touching private body parts (we define this to students as the area covered by swimsuits).

They'll also learn to say no to unsafe or unwanted touches, and to tell an adult if someone breaks rules about touching private body parts. Students will also practice asking an adult for help, telling an adult about an unsafe situation, and being assertive to get out of unsafe situations.

Families are the most important part of their child's safety. That's why we're committed to providing you with information and training to support your child:

- If you have any questions about the Child Protection Unit or the Second Step program, please contact your student's school counselor. You are welcome to review with the school counselor the lesson(s) used. The Counseling page on the APS website contains additional details about our Second Step lessons. Please note, APS employees and volunteers receive annual training on these issues.
- We also encourage families and caregivers to participate in adult-focused prevention trainings, which can help you support your child at home. Find more information about training offered in English and Spanish <a href="here">here</a>.
