NNAT & CoGAT Testing Next Week

Next week our **first-grade students** will be taking the **Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test (NNAT3)**. The NNAT3 test is given to all Arlington Public Schools students in grade 1 in the fall. The timed test is given online and takes 30 minutes. Items on the test are presented as figures that require spatial analysis, but no verbal knowledge or skills are required. The NNAT3 fosters a normative

understanding of general ability without reliance on language, culture, or institutionalized curriculum.

Also, our **2nd through 5th graders** who have <u>not</u> previously taken the **Cognitive Abilities Test** (**CogAT**) will be given the assessment. All elementary schools will be giving this assessment to students in grades 2 - 5 who have not previously taken the CogAT in an APS elementary school. The CogAT provides a snapshot of your student's reasoning and problem-solving abilities in the following three areas:

- **Verbal**: assesses a student's abilities to use search, retrieval and comparison processes that are essential for verbal reasoning.
- **Quantitative**: assesses a student's ability to reason about patterns and relationships using concepts that are essential in quantitative thinking.
- **Nonverbal**: assesses student's abilities to reason with somewhat more novel questions that use spatial and figural content.

The results of the assessment will serve several functions. First and foremost, the results will be used to drive instructional practices in the classroom. The scores will guide efforts to adapt teaching methods to the needs and abilities of students. The scores are also used as one component of the holistic case study approach to determine areas of strength and possible screening for gifted services.

The results of these tests will be used by your child's teacher to inform the instruction of your child. Your child's teacher should have informed you of their testing schedule. We ask that you avoid scheduling any appointments that would require your student to be absent from school during this testing window. It is very important that your student arrives at school on time on testing day. Please be sure your student has a good night's sleep before test day and eats a good breakfast on the morning(s) of the test. **iPads should remain at school during this testing period.**
