Throughout the month of February, APS will celebrate **Black History Month**. The focus of this year is Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and the paramount role these institutions play in educating the African American community. Interest in HBCUs has piqued recently since people became aware that newly elected Vice President Kamala Harris attended Howard University, an HBCU located in Washington, DC. HBCUs serve as an incubator for the success of many African American, both famous and local to Arlington, so APS will highlight the HBCU experience during Black History Month by exploring the history and relevance of HBCUs.

Each week will have a theme related to this year's focus.  **Save the Date: MPSA's Virtual Walk for Education**



The children in our Montessori community are taught early on to care about others. We teach mindfulness and encourage kindness beginning in their first year as new 3-year-olds to Primary and throughout their time here. Their desire to help others grows larger year after year as their empathy and compassion grows. It is for this reason that Montessori has dedicated time every year to support bringing water to the children of the **Azawak**, the dry, impoverished land encompassing parts of Niger, Algeria and Mali.

The great news is there is a way for our community to continue to their philanthropy despite the pandemic! MPSA is proud to be a part of **a virtual walk** to help raise funds to support the education of the children of the Azawak. This walk's focus will be on the townships of Tatiste and Fak where the finished "**Water is Education**" borehole was completed in December, a project that our students, along with students around the world, helped to fund. With water now flowing, now we are focusing on education. The money we raise will go towards providing supplies to the schools in those regions as well as funding higher level education to ten young women.

More information will be coming soon, including how to register and participate in the virtual walk which will take place beginning on **Presidents' Day, February 15**, through **World Water Day, March 22**.
