National Walk, Bike & Roll to School Day is October 4

Join APS and participate in National Walk, Bike & Roll to School Day, Wednesday October 4. If you are able, students and their families should pick one of the human-powered ways to get to school:

- Walking: Foot power!
- Bike: Riding their own bikes or riding tandem with a sibling or caregiver
- Roll: Skates, rollerblades, foot powered scooters and the like.

Drivers can participate in this event by parking somewhere nearby in the neighborhood (paying attention to street signs) and walking the rest of the way to school. This event was created to draw attention to the need of more safe and protected routes to school for the students who do not use a bus or car as well as promote environmental care by finding ways to reduce our carbon footprint.
