From the MPSA Reading Specialists: We created the Wonderful World of Words bulletin board exhibit to enhance the content area vocabulary of the classroom. Having multiple exposures to concepts and related vocabulary provides opportunities for children to explore and experience nomenclature. With repeated exposure and practice, key vocabulary words become part of the child's lexicon.









#### October 16-20, 2023, is National Bus Safety Week!

**National School Bus Safety Week**: Held during the third full week of October each year, **National School Bus Safety Week** is an active and evolving public education program and an excellent way for parents, students, teachers, motorists, school bus operators, school administrators, and other interested parties to join forces and address the importance of school bus safety. Designed to promote school bus safety, school districts throughout the country observe School Bus Safety Week.

This is the perfect time of year to visit safety tips for riding the school bus. As winter approaches and daylight hours get shorter, knowing these safety tips will help all students who ride the bus get to school safely each day.

#### ON THE WAY TO THE BUS

- Be Alert. Arrive at your stop at least TEN minutes early.
- Obey all traffic lights and signals.
- Plan to walk with schoolmates when possible and face traffic.
- When crossing streets, always cross at crosswalks and intersections.
- Look both ways before crossing the street.

#### AT THE BUS STOP

- Stand back from the curb or road at least three giant steps.
- Don't push or shove when entering or exiting and always use the steps and handrail.
- Always obey the bus driver and wait for the driver's signal before crossing.
- Always cross at least 10 feet in front of the school bus.
- Never crawl under the bus. If you drop something under the bus, notify the bus driver.

#### WHEN RIDING THE BUS

- Take your seat quietly and quickly. Remain seated while the bus is moving.
- Keep your feet on the floor and never extend your hands, arms, head, or any object out the window of the bus.
- Talk in a quiet voice, be courteous to the driver and schoolmates and try not to distract the driver through misbehavior.

In this presentation, **Dr. Jonathan Dalton**, of the <u>Center for Anxiety and Behavioral Change</u>, will focus on practical, yet sometimes counter-intuitive evidence-based skills and techniques to help their children

and teens experience less anxiety and develop greater tolerance for emotional distress. Specific topics include why anxiety and avoidance are teammates, how to teach specific coping skills to your children, which types of positive reinforcement should be used to decrease anxiety, and when active ignoring of anxious behavior is the best method to decrease the child's experience of anxiety.
