5th Grade Parents – HACP & Middle School Information

The Home Address Confirmation Process (HACP) begins on November 27th. ALL 5th grade families are required to provide the school with a copy of your deed/lease and two current proofs of address to confirm your residency here in Arlington. Families who recently submitted renewed leases or updated A/B Forms in September/October are still required to send in the supporting documentation. Families who do not submit their documents by the deadline of January 26th will have their students and their siblings (regardless of which school they are attending) withdrawn from APS at the end of the year. All documents received will be researched and verified for validity.

You do not need to wait until November 27th to start submitting your documents. You can e-mail them now, or drop them off in person, to Kia Haynes (kia.stevensonhaynes@apsva.us).

Homeowners: Arlington County will provide you with a free copy of your deed. E-mail **Arlington County Land Records** at landrec@arlingtonva.us making the request, being sure to include your child's school and school ID# in the request for enrollment confirmation.

Middle school information sessions have been scheduled. Each middle school offers an in-person information session between December and January. Families are encouraged to attend to learn about their assigned neighborhood school or option school of interest, meet school staff, and ask questions.

MPSA's Lost & Found is Getting FULL

The MPSA Lost & Found is packed! Help keep the Lost & Found clear by labeling EVERYTHING with your child's name – and we mean EVERYTHING because you should not take for granted that your child, or your child's teacher, will be aware of every lost item. If the items are labeled, we can get the items back to your child.

The Lost & Found is in the cafeteria. When you enter, you will find it on the right side where the hooks & shelf is. If your child is missing items, please encourage them to go search through there for their things. If they are younger, you yourself are welcome to come search through items either before school starts or after the school day has ended. You can also come look on during teacher work days (when the office is open but school is closed); after school on early release days; during Extended Day pick up or other times when you may be in the building (e.g. chaperoning, volunteering.)

We also have an Instagram for our Lost & Found. Follow it here and check often to see if any of the items your child is missing has made it there. Found jewelry is kept in the main office. Caveat: While we try to post as many items as we can, due to the sheer volume, not every item will be photographed.

Items not claimed by November 21st, the day before Thanksgiving break, will be donated to local churches. APS is not required to store lost items; therefore we highly recommend that you come check out the Lost & Found before that date.
