Almost 8:55AM? Go Directly to the Main Door.

If you are dropping your student off in the morning, and you do not think you will make it to Door #5 before it closes at 8:55AM, then drive directly to the main entrance and walk your child inside. Since you will not be staying long, you will be permitted to park against the curb while you run in to sign your child in. Your children will be allowed to go to class while you sign them in, and this way, they might still be on time. This is also a suggested solution for those who pull up to drop off at Door #5 and find themselves at the end of a long line. Follow the orange detour signs on S. Highland Street and enter by the Arlington Career Center to get to the front of the school. Please be mindful of students crossing the lot.

As a reminder, we recommend parents who drop their students off to school arrive at the latest by 8:50AM. Door #5 opens at 8:30AM so there is plenty of time to get your child to school on time. Please do not yell at or argue with our school staff for enforcing APS policies. Instead, direct your disagreement with the APS attendance policy about unexcused tardiness to engage@apsva.us.
