Keep Up the Routine of Attendance

As we prepare to take time off from school for the Thanksgiving break, we are grateful for everyone who has helped to restore a routine for showing up to school while supporting students and families. **Daily routines are essential for reducing stress and creating a sense of security.** If your child is healthy, please encourage showing up to class when school is in session. Every day of school is an important opportunity for students to learn as well as connect to peers and their teachers. For more information, review this resource from Attendance Works.

All attendance should be reported to Montessori Attendance by either calling 703-228-2037 or emailing montessori.attendance@apsva.us. You can also report an absence in ParentVUE. If you only email your child's teacher, we might not be aware of the absence or tardy and you'll receive a robocall. Attendance should be reported before 10:30AM to avoid the call.

A reminder that 15 consecutive absences will result in your child being unenrolled from APS, regardless of whether the absences are excused, or you return to school on the 16th day. Your child will be able to be enrolled back into APS upon return, however, you will lose your spot in our program and will have to attend your neighborhood school (if eligible). The only caveat to this is if the absences are health related and addressed in a student's IEP or 504 plan.

Head Lice Questions & Tips

What is the lice management plan for APS?

The role of School Health staff in lice management is to:

- Provide education to parents/guardians, children and staff about head lice
- Help identify students with head lice
- Make recommendations to parents/guardians about treatment of head lice
- Work in conjunction with families and teachers to identify lice and with health providers to treat and manage lice infestations.

What happens if my child is discovered to have nits/lice at school?

If your child is noted to have head lice or nits in school, you will be notified by clinic staff who will provide recommendations regarding treatment. Your child will not be publicly embarrassed or singled out, nor will they be required to leave school early.

Will the school notify families if a child with lice is discovered?

The clinic will send home a letter notifying the parents of the classroom the child with lice is in. If there is an unusually large number of infestations, a notice to the entire school community would be sent out.

What are some ways we can help prevent the spread of lice?

- Avoid head-to-head (hair-to-hair) contact during play and other activities at home, school, and elsewhere (sports activities, playground, slumber parties, camp).
- Do not share clothing such as hats, scarves, coats, sports uniforms, hair ribbons, or barrettes.

Everyone should practice these prevention measures. People with any hair type can get lice. A person's degree of cleanliness or personal hygiene also has nothing to do with getting head lice.

Inclement Weather Procedures

Please review our <u>inclement weather procedures here</u> and ensure you have a plan in place should we need to close schools or change arrival or dismissal due to weather.

Based on the number of minutes available, we have **13 days** available for weather events and other unexpected school closures. We will therefore allow for 13 traditional snow days. After 13 days off due to weather (should we reach that amount) we will transition to **distance learning** on any additional snow days to meet our required 990 hours of instructional time and to avoid extending our school year.

Gift Card Drive for Winter Break

Winter break is a fun time for most of us, but for some of our families, it's a time of stress because access to two hot meals a day will be missing for 10 days. It is for this reason that we are continuing our

annual tradition of collecting **grocery store gift cards** to help keep our food-insecure families stocked up for the additional burden of having to provide 20 more meals per child during the break. At this time, we have identified 13 families who will need help this season. We anticipate more reaching out for help as the break gets closer. Our goal is to collect enough gift cards to supply each family with at least \$100 to supplement their food budget.

With that said, if you are willing to **donate** a **grocery store gift card** (or gift card to a store that has a grocery section, like Target or Walmart) please drop off to **Kia Haynes** in the main office. Please keep the denominations for each gift card small (\$25 or less) so we can more evenly divvy up the cards amongst our families. **A tip to get more bang for your donated buck:** Purchase gift cards from **Aldi's**, where the food quality is still great but for much less than a typical chain store.

We will also take cash donations. Those will go directly to our social worker, Kristin Decker, who will purchase the gift cards and provide receipts of purchase if you would like. We will not be issuing cash to any families. **We need all gift cards in hand by December 11**th. We humbly thank you in advance.
