Monday is Earth Day!

Earth Day this year occurs on Monday, April 22nd. This year's global theme is Planet vs. Plastic. The Upper Elementary classes will be going into the Lower Elementary and Primary classrooms to share some aspects of taking care of our earth.

To incorporate the celebration of our diversity into Earth Day, we would like to continue the tradition of having each student bring in a plant or seedling of their choice. If each child brings in one plant, we will be able to plant over 500 plants in our gardens. What a spectacular way to concretely illustrate our unique school culture and range of our beauty! Plants can be brought in all week as planting will happen throughout the week. Please do not send in vegetable or fruit plants. Herbs are okay!

Plants are widely available at almost every grocery store if you do not want to make a trip to a garden center. There are also plants sold at hardware stores such as Lowes and Home Depot. Wakefield High School is also having a plant sale! It opens at 10AM and is open through 2PM. Proceeds benefit their PTSA. If purchasing a plant is a hardship, a packet of seeds for flowers, plants and herbs, are welcome. You can varieties for about a \$1.

If your child has gardening gloves, please allow them to bring them to school next week. If you are willing to loan us the use of gardening tools for planting, please bring to the main office or hand them to a staff member at pick up or drop off. Please do not send garden tools with children on the bus. The Upper Elementary students will be assisting younger students with planting throughout the week. It will be a great way for Upper Elementary to connect with their younger fellow students.

As students go through the library doors, they discover so many possibilities. Libraries have spaces for independent reading, collaborative group work and space for whole classes to learn together. The library is a welcoming space for all students and is ready to meet the inquiry needs of each one.

Students can go to the library for so many reasons and each time their library staff is there to welcome and engage with them and support their individual needs. Would You Like to Be an MPSA Homemade Orchestra Donor?

Over the last several weeks, UEM students spent a lot of time observing and thinking about how instruments initiate, amplify and manipulate sound. We've practiced organizing instruments according to the Hornbostel-Sachs system's 5 basic classifications:

- 1. Aerophones: sounds initiated via vibrating column of air
- 2. Chordophones: sounds initiated via vibrating strings
- 3. Electrophones: sounds initiated electronically or with **electronic** components.
- 4. Idiophones: sounds produced by the vibration of an instrument's body
- 5. Membranophone: sounds produced by vibrating membranes/skins

We've engaged in some exploratory problem-solving using VA Tech's Innovation Invention Design Process, and we've refined our ideas about instrument design. Now, it's time to start creating!! Please help us!

Our goal is to create instruments that are **musical** (not just noisy), **durable** and **attractive.** Our budget, \$0.00, provides an additional challenge. Consequently, we are looking for materials that are free to all students.

Please consider donating materials (containers, tubes, art supplies, beads, cords/strings, fasteners, fabric, films/membranes) that can help with the construction of durable and attractive aerophones, chordophones, idiophones and membranophones. Materials can be recycled or new; please make sure

they are clean and safe for children. All donated items may be sent directly to Ms. Shakespeare's classroom; leftovers will be donated to our art department for future, creative endeavors.

We can't wait to share our instruments with the MPSA community!

SPOILER ALERT: the grand unveiling of our "homemade" orchestra will be at MPSA's STEAM fair on May 3.
