## Welcome to Scouting! Pack 104 Would Love to Have You!

Pack 104 is a local den looking to recruit new members.

Who can join Cub Scouts? Boys and girls in grades K-5 at any school can join Pack 104.

### What happens at Cub Scout meetings?

Cub Scouts aims to teach kids citizenship, leadership, character, and fitness by completing adventures as a group. There are two kinds of meetings: Den meetings (organized by grade, 1-2 meetings per month) and Pack meetings (for all grades together, 1 meeting or event per month).

- **Den meetings** are built around set themes, including outdoor safety, environmental stewardship, sportsmanship, good citizenship, and cooperation.
- Pack meetings are for all the Dens together. Our events include camping twice a year; assisting with a fall food drive for local charities; holding a bonfire party; building and racing Pinewood Derby cars; and celebrating our year with a pizza party.

#### When and where are the meetings?

Each Den decides when and where to meet, usually on the weekends and about once a month.

#### How much does it cost?

We haven't set the final dues figure for 2024-2025 yet. Last year the dues were \$200 for the first Cub Scout in the family, \$175 for any others. There may be additional fees for the camping events to get into the parks, but we will provide the main meals at those events. **Financial assistance is available.** We don't want anyone to miss out because of cost!

#### What does that cost cover?

Of the dues, \$160 goes to our national and district organizations to cover registration, insurance, background checks, and other administrative costs. The rest covers food at our events, award badges, and other items provided by the Pack. **We don't do any fundraising** other than dues.

## What about the uniform?

Families must supply the Cub Scout's uniform. But before you buy anything, please look through our box of hand-me-downs. We only ask for Scouts to wear the waist-up parts of the uniform.

#### Is anything else expected of a Cub Scout family?

We need your help to make this program fun! We hope that each family will pitch in by hosting a Den meeting, helping out at a Pack event, or helping with planning or organizing the program.
