May SEL Notes for Families

As parents, we worry about whether our kids will make friends and will be equipped to adapt to life's challenges. Social emotional learning, commonly shortened to SEL, represents the set of skills your child needs to thrive throughout their life. SEL is commonly described by five core competencies: self-awareness, self-management, responsible decision making, relationship skills, and social awareness. Very simply put, SEL allows children and adults to understand their own emotions and the emotions of others, and to use this understanding in their choices and relationships.

While "SEL" has become a common buzz word among educators, social emotional learning does not just occur in the classroom; it is an important part of our home, as well. Here are five easy social emotional learning activities for children (and adults!) to support SEL in your home.

Updated Respiratory Illness Guidance

APS has updated its Respiratory Illness Guidance based upon recent updates from the Centers for Disease Control and the Virginia Department of Health. Please review this guidance, which removes the requirement for students and staff to remain out of school/work for five days following a diagnosis of COVID. Please note:

- Students and staff must remain out of school/work until they are fever free for 24 hours without the aid of fever reducing medication and symptoms are improving.
- When returning to school/work after a respiratory illness, mitigating measures are recommended such as localized air filters, masking, and a re-emphasis on hygiene practices.
- Attendance clerks should continue to ask about the nature of an illness when a parent/guardian
 calls in to report an absence, and communicable disease such as COVID, influenza, and RSV
 should continue to be reported to the school nurse.

• Families who have children with significant health concerns may reach out to the school to discuss their child's individual needs and possible mitigating measures

Do Good While Eating Mexican Food!




